

**Town of Pacolet
Special Called Meeting
April 13, 2023**

Mayor Camby called the meeting to order. All members were present. The agenda was prepared and posted as required.

The Mayor read over the FOIA Statement.

Council Member McBeth gave the Invocation, with the Pledge of Allegiance following.

1. Executive Session Regarding Personnel

Council Member Wright motioned to go into Executive Session regarding personnel. Council Member Sexton seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. (7:00 p.m.)

Council returned to Regular Session. (7:22 p.m.) No vote was taken while in Executive Session.

2. Consider Accepting a Bid for the Upfitting of 3 Pacolet Police Department Interceptors

Council Member Wright motioned to approve the bid from Campbell-Brown \$34,989.33 for the upfitting of three Pacolet Police Department Interceptors. Council Member Williams seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

3. Consider Accepting a Purchase Request for Two 2020 Dodge Durango's

Council had discussion on the two purchase requests for 2020 Dodge Durango's. The sell of the two cars would go toward the purchase of the three new cars. Council Member Wright requested a resolution stating that the money from the sale of the two cars would go into the General Fund and would also allow the purchasing agent to sign off on the sale. Council Member Williams motioned to go with the quote from Wellford City Police Department and the money go into the General Fund. Council Member Wright asked that resolution be written and presented next week at the Special Called meeting. Mr. Kay will check to see if there is an expiration date on the quote. There was no second to Council Member Williams motion.
